Re: Third drop-in session added for the exhibition of *Pakenham East Precinct Structure Plan*

The Victorian Planning Authority (VPA) and Cardinia Shire Council have released a draft plan for a new community in Pakenham East. The *Pakenham East Precinct Structure Plan (PSP)* includes proposals for schools, a local town centre, infrastructure and homes.

Amendment C234 proposes to incorporate the *Pakenham East Precinct Structure Plan* into the *Cardinia Planning Scheme*, as well as the *Pakenham East Native Vegetation Precinct Plan* and *Small Lot Housing Code*.

The PSP is now on exhibition and people are invited to make submissions until 23 February 2018. You may have received notification of this exhibition earlier in January.

The VPA wishes to advise that an extra drop-in session has been scheduled in Nar Nar Goon on Tuesday 13 February from 5.30pm – 7.30pm. This will give more people the chance to discuss the draft plan with representatives from the VPA and Council. If this location is more convenient for you or your community group, please feel free to drop-in between the advertised hours.

Tuesday 6 February, Pakenham Library, 4.30pm – 6.00pm

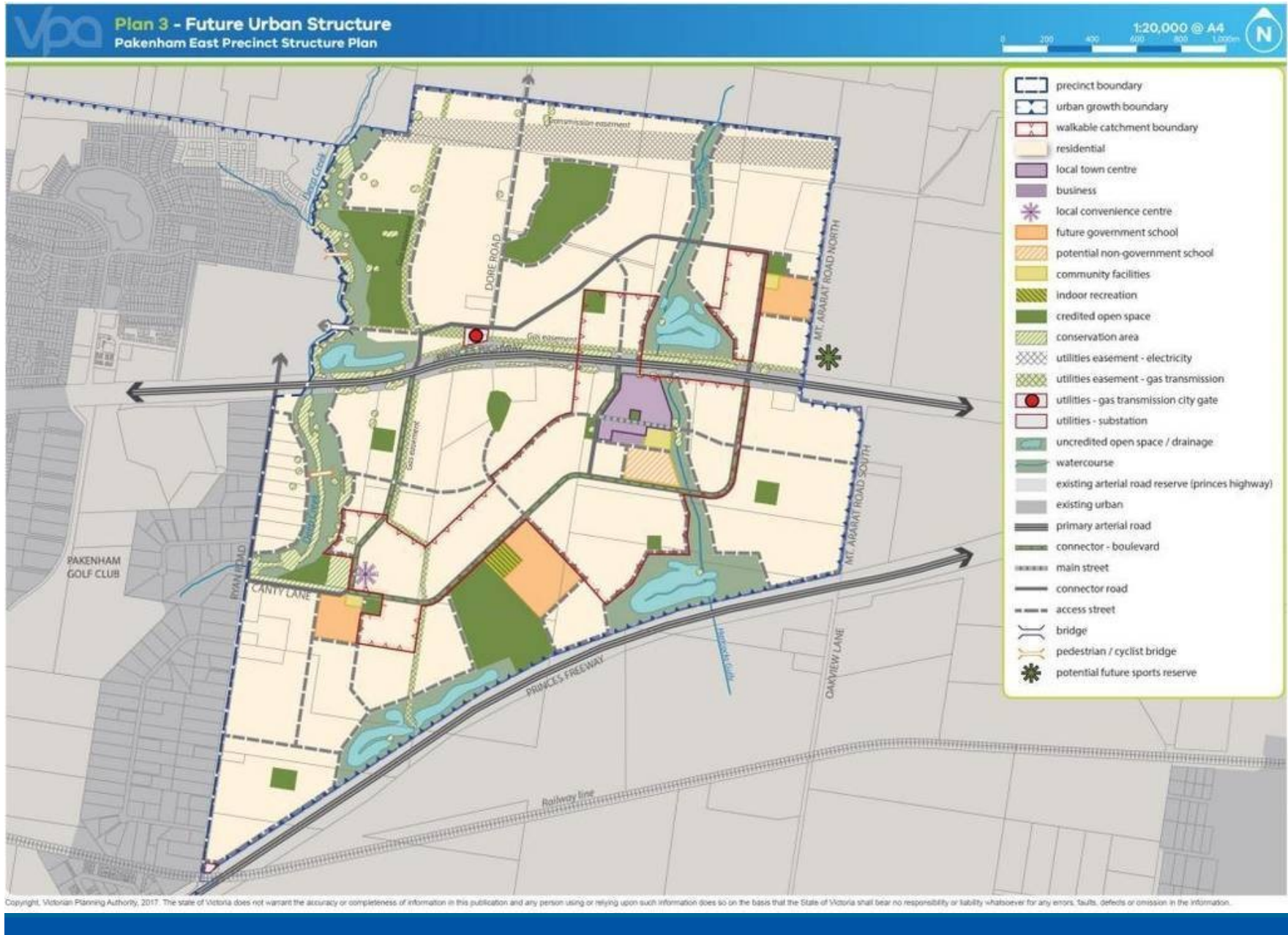
Thursday 15 February, Pakenham Library, 5.30pm – 7.00pm
